(Doug Hayne)**

Jenny Morcombe and I attended the Probus Association of Victoria Annual
General Meeting on Tuesday 24th November.

The quarterly general meeting was held first with the usual routine items
plus reports from the Variety Concert, Probus Wanderers, and the Probus
Victoria golf day which some of our members attended.

Following an embarrassing situation experienced by one of the clubs where
an attempt was made to contact a recently deceased person to speak at their
meeting, we were advised to alert our speaker officers to check the status
and health of potential guest speakers.

An item for consideration in the coming year was to find ways of attracting
“Baby Boomers” to probus clubs.

Fran Sirio from APT, a Probus Victoria sponsor, gave a short talk about
mystery tours and trips available for 2010.

For the AGM, a vote on approval of The Presidential expenses for
attending the 2009 yearly rendezvous of an amount above the previously
approved figure of \$1000 being \$1130.00. There was also a vote to
increase the approved amount to \$1500 for future events. Both passed by
show of hands.

After confirmation and acceptance of the previous meeting minutes and the

Tales of Traveling (Doug Hayne)

We all remember the great times we had during our travel experiences. The not so great times are usually put at the back of the mental file of the trip. The full days walk around an exciting landscape or city is certainly remembered in more detail and with fondness compared to the cold rainy day in the caravan (depending on who your companion is) or the 36 hour flight to or from your destination. So, when we talk with people about our travels we naturally tend to concentrate on the good times.

So, when someone is contemplating a trip and asks the traveler about their experiences, one wonders if they get the best idea of what it is like to do that trip. Often the person we are asking has done the trip once, with a particular tour at a particular time. Even if we visit a place a second time we have had only a small sample of it. So we should be careful when we talk with others about our travels. We need to think a bit deeper and provide a balanced view of what it was like.

As mentioned, the good times come to mind easily and so, perhaps we are justifying our decisions, expense and time put into the trip by exaggerating somewhat or just concentrating on the good times.. Although, sometimes people seem to like complaining about the ridiculous prices or tipping policies, or the bad manners of the locals or the incompetence of the airlines and tour guides. Feeling the need to vent our anger about bad happening does not help the person wanting to gain information about an important decision they have to make.

When we return from our trip we are anxious to "tell everyone about it" and justifiably so. They all ask "how was the trip?" I have never been able to think of a suitable short answer to this question. I am sure the person asking is usually just being polite and nice to us and is not expecting a detailed story of our experiences. If they are contemplating the same trip then perhaps we could ask them around for a "picture night" (They aren't slide shows any more). - Now we have started something!

The digital age has provided us with the ability to take thousands of images or movie moments on a single trip away. So, we really need to work hard to make these images work to present our experience and what we saw in an interesting and informative way.

I can look through several hundred images I have taken on a trip without being bored once. because each have a real image and experience behind them for me. But if I was sitting there explaining every moment of the experience around every image to someone else they wouldn't want to be there for long even if they were planning the same trip or had been on it themselves..

So how can we pass on our experiences to others who may or may not have done the same trip, without scaring, boring or offending them?

I suggest that you do it with a theme night with the show being a prominent but short part of the evening. Twenty minutes is usually a reasonable length show depending on how informative and interesting you have made it.

There are two paths to take and I don't believe they can be mixed.

You can show a sequence of images of "What we saw"- not involving your traveling group to any extent. When selecting these images there should be little explanation needed of what is there and where it is located as these should be apparent from the theme of the show, titles which are easy to add these days, and the content of the image. Appropriate music accompanying the images works well.

The other path is "What we did". Images of the people in the group DOING something other than standing in front of and blocking the view of the local scenery looking into the camera with a thumbs up above the person in front of them.

We all believe you went there and you only really need one picture of you there to prove it!

Images that work here are with someone looking away from the camera at artwork or a scene or a building with the items of interest dominating the picture.

Perhaps you hired bikes and a shot of you on the bike in an identifiable scene or with the interesting hire car you had, would work OK. Some good shots of the group at lunch or sitting by the pool or in funny situations can be interesting provided the audience knows most of the people.

Commentary on this type of show would do well, but remember that all of your audience have experienced professional commentary and so a lot of work on the script is needed and perhaps if you could get a friend who is a good speaker to read your commentary it could work better.

Of course two shows, one of each put on at different times during the get together would work well provided they are short and interesting.

A last piece of advice. Don't select images for your show, decide on the number of images you are going to use and select the ones you will leave out, you know the images that MUST be included.

A 20 minute show with 3 to 5 seconds for each image will take around 250 images. Thats enough information for anyone to absorb in 20 minutes.
